Supports family engagement	Lead PBIS incentives	Handing out medication
Coordinate volunteers	Count and Distribute Hand 2 Hand/Kids Food Baskets	On-going secretarial work
Build and maintain community partnerships	Arrival/dismissal support	Be the point person when the principal is out
Facilitate monthly CSLT	Chaperone field trips	Substitute teaching
Staff wellness support	Interpretation for attendance phone calls and parent teacher meetings	Interpret at IEPs
Support PBIS as a Team Member	Translating school documents for parent communication	Transport students
Serve on Attendance Team	Participate in student leadership groups	Solely leading attendance
